
Deck layout diagram

Bottom view with planks




Top view with planks





Permit Page: Level 1



LOAD AND SUPPORT:

Your deck will support a 51 PSF live load. Posts have 36" below ground support.

DECK AND POST HEIGHT:

You selected a height of 18" from the top of the decking to the ground level. The top of the deck support posts will therefore be 9" above ground level.

Joists:

Set joists on top of beams, 12"; center to center.



Beam Layout Level 1


